RULES AND REGULATIONS

-This tournament is sanctioned by the Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) and is open to all bowlers affiliated with CTF through the Winnipeg Tenpin Bowling Association (WTBA). CTF registered participants from other associations will be required to pay the WTBA Local Association dues (\$4.00) in order to participate. Unattached and affiliate CTF registered participants cards are also available.

-CTF youth 15 years and older are eligible to bowl. Parental consent forms for youth 15-17 must be signed by their parents.

-No verbal or telephone entries will be accepted.

-All entrants will bowl eight qualifying games on Saturday, moving lanes after each game. The top 16 bowlers will advance to Sunday's finals. There will be no charge for bowling on Sunday.

Report time Sunday is 9:55 A.M. sharp Sunday dress code will be in effect. No Jeans or Caps.

-A tie for 16th position on Saturday will be broken by a one game roll-off. Ties in the stepladder finals will be broken by a three-frame roll-off.

-Match game play will be bowled in two divisions, A and B.

-Each bowler will play every competitor in his division once, with the 8th game being a position match of all qualifiers.

-On the second day twenty (20) bonus pins will be awarded for each win, ten (10) bonus pins for each tie and zero (0) bonus pins for a loss.

-The top five (5) bowlers after match play will advance to the stepladder finals. The bowler in 5th position will bowl against the bowler in 4th position. The winner will advance to bowl against the bowler in 3rd position. The winner will advance to bowl against the bowler in second position. The winner will advance to bowl against the bowler in first position to declare the winner. Leader to be beaten once.

-The decision of the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with CTF rule 329.

ALL CTF RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL BE OBSERVED

\$50.00 will be presented to the bowler with the highest total pin count during Saturday's qualifying round.

\$25.00 shall be awarded to the entrant bowling the highest single game on Saturday. In the event of a tie, the next highest game of those involved in the tie shall determine the winner.

DICK MARINELLI SENIOR

Dick Marinelli passed away in 1980 and was, up to that time, very involved in the sport of Tenpin, not only as a participant, but also as an administrator and organizer. He was the City Singles Champion, as well as the Provincial Singles Scratch Champion in 1955. In 1958, he was again the Provincial Singles Scratch Champion and then went on to become the Western Canadian Champion.

He was involved in forming the Canadian Tenpin Federation and the Manitoba Provincial Association, and was the Association's first president. He held executive positions with the Provincial Association as well as the Winnipeg Bowling Association for many years. He was also instrumental in organizing the Junior Bowling Association. Dick Marinelli was inducted into the Bowling Hall of Fame of Manitoba in 1988.

Mrs. Marinelli passed away in 1993.

He and his family have sponsored the City Singles Scratch Championship since 1960, and Dick Marinelli Jr. and sons Denis and Chris continue to act as one of our main sponsors.
