1. This tournament will be conducted as a singles event consisting of 3 games plus Handicap.
2. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between 240 and the bowler's average.
3. Prize ratio 1 in 3 and prize fees returned 100%.
4. All bowlers must be a CTF registered participant for the current season. Youth bowlers aged 15 and over are eligible to bowl.
5. A bowler must use his/her highest previous season's sanctioned league average of a minimum of 21 games. If there is no previous season average, the present season average based on 21 or more games must be used. All other bowlers will bowl scratch.
6. All CTF tournament and playing rules will be strictly enforced unless otherwise stated in the entry form. Tournament Director is final authority.
7. Rule 319a (3) applies. (Incorrect average)
8. Rule 319d does not apply. (Prize winnings)
9. Rule 319e applies. (Average adjustments)
10. Entries close 15 minutes prior to start of last shift.
