This will be a 6 game event bowled in two 3 game blocks in two divisions Open and Women's. This will be a handicap event. The handicap will be 90% and the scratch mark will be 220. A bowler may bowl in two 3 game blocks as a singles entry or in 3 games singles and 3 games doubles. Doubles may be Open, Women or Mixed. Bowlers must bowl one set of singles as part of their 6 game block. CTF Rule 317 regarding multiple participation shall apply. It is the first 6 games bowled that qualify for CINCINNATI OHIO July 30--Aug 2,2024 A bowler must use his/her highest previous season's average. If the current average for 21 games or more is ten pins higher at time of bowling then the current average must be used. If the bowler has no previous average, the current average for 21 or more games must be used. If a bowler has none of the above, then he/she must bowl scratch (CTF RULE 319A).

IT SHALL BE EACH BOWLER'S RESPOSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF HIS/HERS AVERAGE, WHETHER ORIGINALLY SUBMITTED BY THE BOWLER OR OTHERS. FAILURE TO USE THE PROPER AVERAGE OR MAKE CORRECTIONS PRIOR TO OR AT TIME OF BOWLING SHALL DISQUALIFY SCORE IF SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN ACTUAL AVERAGE. PRIZE WINNINGS WILL BE BASED ON SUBMITTED AVERAGE IF IT IS HIGHER. ALL BOWLERS WILL CERTIFY THEIR AVERAGE AT TIME OF BOWLING (PRIOR TO ROLLING THE FIRST BALL) BY INITIALING THE SCORE SHEET. CTF RULE 319E —RERATING RULE APPLIES. (The bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by 15 or more pins. In that case, the accumulated average must be used for handicapping. Entrants may compete as often as they wish in the Doubles events but shall be eligible for only one prize in the prize list with the same partner. Entrants may enter as often as they wish in the Singles event but may cash only once. It is the first 6 games that will qualify for you to go to CINCINNATI and one set must be a single event. If you wish to enter additional singles event the cost would be \$40.00.

## IT WILL BE THE BOWLERS RESPONSIBILITY TO COVER ALLTRAVEL EXPENSES FOR TOURNAMENT, U.S.B.C. MEMBERSHIP, TRAVEL, HOTEL AND ENTRY FEE OF \$180.00 US FUNDS.

The highest 6 game total with handicap for 6 men in the open division and 6 women in different classifications will qualify to represent Manitoba in this event. In the event of a tie, the bowler with the highest single game in the 6 game qualifying score will qualify. If a bowler cannot bowl in the USBC Seniors Championships, he/she must forfeit any funding and the next in line will qualify. USBC ONLY ALLOWS ONE ENTRY PER CLASSIFICATION FROM EACH PROVINCE. . NOTE: ALL PEOPLE TRAVELING BY AIR OR CAR MUST HAVE A VALID PASSPORT.

All prize winners must verify their age by presentation of a valid birth certificate. A bowler must be 50 years of age or over and have a CTF card for the current season to enter this tournament. A bowler must have reached his/her 50<sup>th</sup> birthday at time of bowling in order to participate.
