#### WINNIPEG TENPIN BOWLING ASSOCIATION 106<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL TOURNAMENT & <u>MANITOBA BOWLING ASSOCIATION ANNUAL TOURNAMENT</u> QUALIFICATIONS AND RULES

- 1. The tournament is a two-day event on January 20 and 21, 2024. Shift times are 9:00 am, 10:30 am and 12:00 noon both days. Bowlers do not have to enter all three events.
- 2. The tournament director has the right to cancel a shift if required.
- 3. This tournament is sanctioned by CTF. Participants must be CTF members for the current season.
- 4. The tournament consists of Teams, Doubles, Men's and Women's Singles, and Men's and Women's Handicap and Scratch events. Three consecutive games will be bowled in each event and the *Total Pins plus Handicap* shall determine the winner. The total of 9 games shall determine the *Scratch All Events* winner and *Total Pins plus Handicap* shall determine the *Handicap All Events* winner for both men and women.
- 5. Multiple participation is allowed however you may cash only once in Singles, only once in Doubles with the same partner, and Teams must change a minimum of two bowlers to cash again. When a bowler competes more than once, his or her first appearance in each event shall count towards his/her all-events score. Bowlers may cash in both the Handicap and Scratch divisions if both are entered. Limitations as above.
- 6. Intent to enter the Optional Scratch, Handicap, and/or Senior Adults/Master All Events must be declared before bowling the first event.
- 7. Closing date of entries is 11:30 am Sunday, January 21, 2024. Entries and re-entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of each shift providing space is available.
- 8. Youth bowlers aged 15 and over as of August 1, 2023, are eligible to bowl.
- 9. Bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to shift time.
- 10. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between 240 and the bowler's average.
- 11. 100% prize fund returned. Pays 1 in 4 entries; all-events pays 1 in 10.
- 12. Entrants must use their highest CTF-sanctioned league average according to the following rules:
  - a. Highest previous winter season average for at least 21 games in a sanctioned league.
  - b. Highest current season average for at least 21 games as of December 31, 2023, if no previous winter season average.
  - c. All others bowl scratch.

**Note:** CTF Rule 319A(2) states that when a tournament uses previous season's average and the entrant has a current season average for 21 games or more which is 10 pins or more higher, the bowler must use the current average for entry in the tournament.

- 13. CTF Rule 319A(3) shall apply (Average Verification).
- 14. CTF Rule 319D does not apply (Reporting Prior Prize Winnings).
- 15. **CTF Rule 319E shall apply** (Average Adjustment for Entry), modified as follows: An adjustment is necessary when the tournament average exceeds the average to be used for entry by 10 or more pins.
- 16. Substitutes are allowed when replacement is necessary. The Tournament Director must be notified of substitution at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time. If a substitute is used after the original bowler has commenced play, only the actual frames bowled by the original entrant shall constitute the bowler's all-events score should it be his/her first appearance in this event. The same rule applies to the substitute whether he/she bowls the complete 3 games or partial games.
- 17. Paid all-events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in all 3 events and the transfer is made by the Tournament Director prior to the time of the substitute's participation in any event.
- 18. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee nor shall the substitute be expected to pay the original entrant any prize money he/she may win.
- 19. Telescores will be the official score.
- 20. Any dispute or disagreement or obvious errors in scoring shall immediately be referred to and decided by the tournament official. A score sheet cannot be changed after it has been signed by the official scorer, captain of the team or individual entrant and officially certified, except an obvious error shall be corrected by the tournament official.
- 21. A committee authorized by the WTBA and MBA Board of Directors shall rule on any appeal or protest and its decision shall be final. The Executive Board of the WTBA and MBA shall decide on any questions not covered by the tournament rules.

- Jan 20-21 Joint WTBA/MBA Annual Tournament Handicap, Singles, Doubles, Teams, All-Events including MBA Senior Adults and Senior Masters All-Events
- Feb 10 A&H "Strike Out Cancer" Doubles Now includes both Men and Women. Handicap event. Has your average improved the most in your league during the qualifying period? Then you may qualify to represent your league. And even if you didn't qualify that way, you can still enter the tournament – on your own. Ask your League Secretary for the details.
- Feb 25 Allan Boes Singles Handicap, open to all sanctioned men and women bowlers.
- Feb 25 5-Divisional Scratch Singles event; 4 games open to Men and Women. You compete against bowlers in your average class. Bowl 4 games and discard your lowest game.

### \*\*NOTE\*\* - The above two tournaments are being run simultaneously, so that for those who want to, they can bowl once, and have the scores count for both tournaments.

- Mar 9-10 Marinelli City Singles Men, Women, and Youth 15 and over scratch singles event – Day 1 is 6 games of qualifying at one centre, and the top 16 advance to Day 2 finals at another centre.
- Mar16-17 Eric & Eleanor Young Memorial Championship Team event; handicap. Qualify thru your league during the 4-week qualifying period. A fun event! Ask your secretary for details!
- Aug 17WTBA Annual General Meeting. Everyone welcome.
