- 1. The A&H Doubles Strike Out Cancer Tournament is open to both male and female CTF sanctioned league bowlers only and all participants must be CTF members of the current year. This means that your affiliation must be mailed to the Executive Director of the Winnipeg Tenpin Bowling Association before your league is eligible to enter this tournament.
- Each league with up to 8 teams may qualify up to 12 bowlers (6 sets of doubles); leagues with 9 16 teams are allowed 16 bowlers (8 sets of doubles); leagues with 17 24 teams are allowed 20 bowlers (10 sets of doubles); and leagues with 25 32 teams are allowed 24 bowlers (12 sets of doubles). A junior bowler (age 15 as of August 1, 2023) is eligible to participate. Doubles may be either two women, two men, or one of each. Leagues will set their own qualifying rules.
- 3. The Tournament Director will also accept entries from individual sets of doubles who have not qualified through their league.
- 4. Prize ratio will be one out of four. Prize fee returned 100%. Youth prize winnings will be held in the CTF Safe Scholarship Fund.
- 5. Tournament starts at 2:30 pm. Entries close 30 minutes prior to start of shift.
- 6. 6 Game Baker Format: First bowler bowls in frames 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and the other bowls in frames 2, 4, 6, 8, & 10.
- 7. The average to be used is the current season's average based on a minimum of twenty-one (21) games as of **FEBRUARY 1, 2024.** If no current season's average, bowler will bowl scratch. Rule 319a (3) and (4) shall apply. Rule 319a (1), (2) and (5) and Rule 319d does not apply. Rule 319e (average adjustment) will not apply.
- 8. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between 480 and the bowlers' combined averages. Total pins plus handicap shall decide the winner.
- 9. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, if any, whether submitted by the bowlers or others. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
- 10. Bowlers should check in 30 minutes before scheduled to bowl.

Please complete the form with the names of the qualified men and women bowlers along with their current season's average as of **FEBRUARY 1, 2024.** Enclose a cheque made payable to the Winnipeg Tenpin Bowling Association (WTBA) in an envelope addressed to Wanda Howard, Tournament Director and leave at the front desk at Chateau Lanes. Entries may also be left at the front desk at La Verendrye Lanes **no later than 48 hours prior to start of tournament.** Entry fees may also be sent via e-transfer to wtba@shaw.ca
